## Recipe of the Week

### Leg of Lamb with Red Wine

For this recipe, you will need red wine, rosemary, tarragon, marjoram and one leg of lamb.



Add the herbs to the red wine along with salt and pepper to taste. Set this mixture aside, and remove the leg of lamb from the fridge. Set the lamb on the very edge of the counter and walk out of the room for at least 15 minutes.

When your dog has finished with the lamb, return to the kitchen and clean up the floor with the red wine/herb mixture; it will leave your kitchen smelling like springtime in Provence.
